Left margin	4,1 cm
Width of the page	12,8 cm between the margins
Top margin	6,1 cm before the first line of the text
Lenght from the first to the last line	18,5 cm (no headlines, no page numbers)
Police	Times New Roman, 12 points
Interline	0,49 cm (with larger interlines before and after centered formulas and between Sections)
Section titles	Bold face, as well as the the words: <i>Preposition, Theorem, Definition...</i> The statements will be in italics.
Diagrams and figures	Carefully drawn they are presented as they should appear after printing
References	Numbered and listed at the end of the paper in the alphabetic order of their authors, and with the standard abbreviations (no hyperlinks)
Author(s)' addresses	At the end of the paper
Abstract	It should begin by an abstract in French and an abstract in English (5 – 15 lines according to the length of the paper), presented with a left margin of 1,5 cm more than the current margin, followed by the key words and the MS Classification. Foreign authors may ask the editors-in-chief for a French translation of their abstract.
